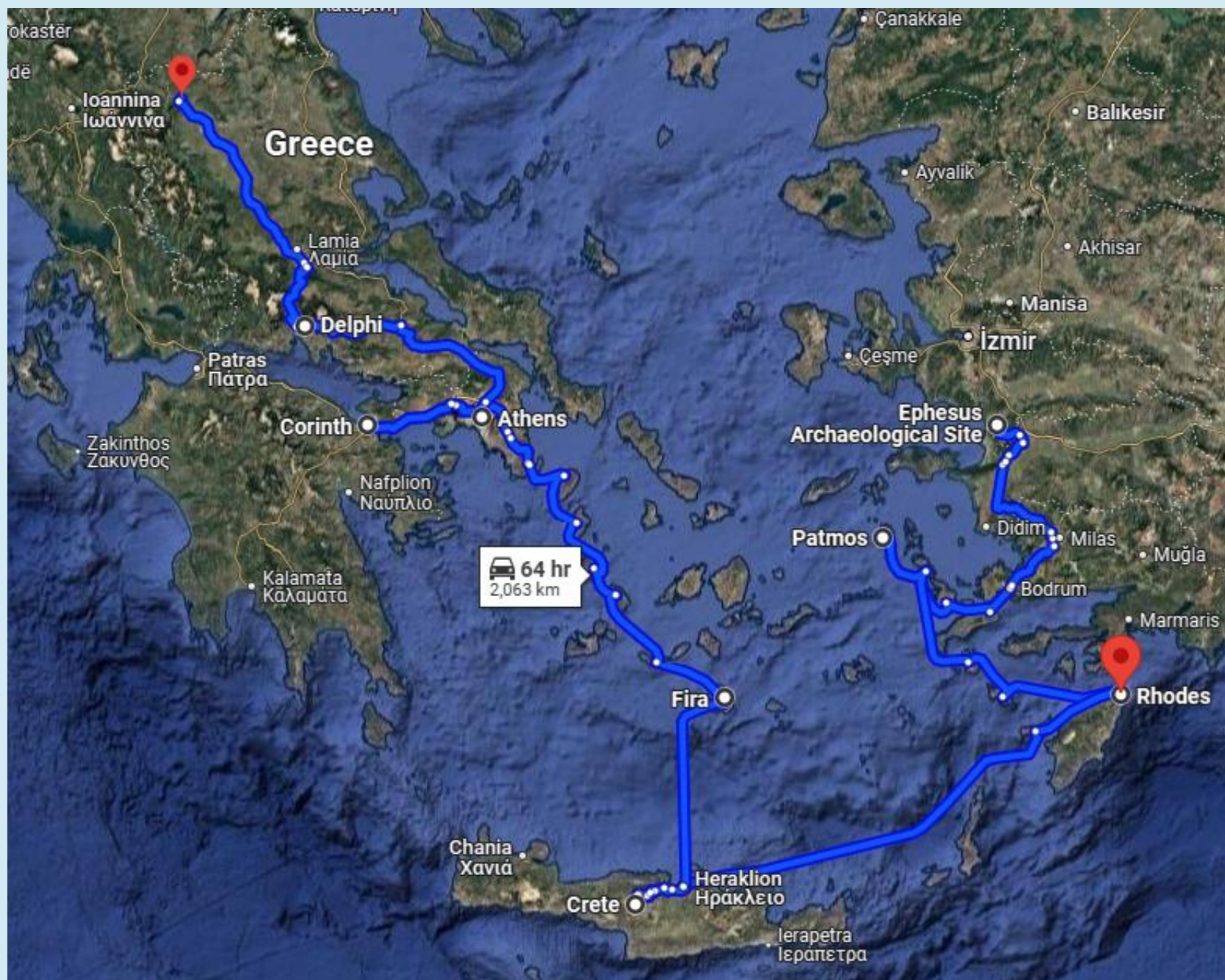
Itinerary

September 26/27	Depart US/arrive Izmir Turkey
September 28	Tour Ephesus
September 29	Board cruise 10am Afternoon tour of Patmos including the cave where John wrote Revelation, depart 9:30pm.
September 30	Island of Rhodes – ½ day tour including Lindos and the fortress + free time, depart 6pm
October 1	Island of Crete in morning, depart 12pm for Santorini including optional transfer to Oia, depart 9:30pm
October 2	Offboard cruise; drive to Corinth and then tour Athens including Acropolis & Mars Hill (Athens overnight)
October 3	Visit Delphi (Kalambaka overnight)
October 4	Visit Meteora (Athens overnight)
October 5	Morning free time in Athens, depart Greece for Israel or to US, late day flights

1-night Kusadasi, 3-nights cruise, 2-nights Athens, 1-night Kalambaka

Itinerary is subject to change due to scheduling needs and local conditions.

- Athens:** Visit the iconic Acropolis and the Parthenon, marvel at the ancient Areopagus where Apostle Paul preached, and explore Ancient Agora. Visit the world-renowned Acropolis Museum, home to ancient Greek artifacts, including sculptures and relics from the Acropolis
- Corinth:** Explore the ancient ruins of Corinth, including the Temple of Apollo and the Corinth Canal, and reflect on Apostle Paul's time in the city
- Delphi:** Discover the ancient site of Delphi, once considered the center of the world, and explore its famous archaeological ruins
- Meteora:** Marvel at the stunning monasteries perched atop rock formations, a UNESCO World Heritage site
